This year in collaboration with ICCHRA, ArtHum (Artists for Humanity) is involved in activities of promoting a culture of tolerance and peace through a world wide human rights campaigning run by Youth for Human Rights International (YHRI).

We are distributing many samples of a DVD made by YHRI. It is called 30 Rights & 30 Ads. This DVD illustrates/explains the Universal Declaration of Human Rights through video clips, each clip for one right.

As we know, there can not be any threat against peace without people's rights violation or misperception. In other words, human rights abuses and misperceptions concerning others' rights generally lead to verbal, structural and physical violence which create humiliation feelings and do harm. These latest do perpetrate cycles of violence and threats against peace.

In Uvira – DR Congo, we have already distributed those DVDs within the Protection cluster framework led by OCHA, UNHCR, MONUC and ICRC. These institutions have adopted the 30 Rights & 30 Ads DVD, they are conducting meetings and seminars - - for the benefit of local organizations and stakeholders - - in which the content of the DVD is exploited.

We have also extended the network in the region, specifically in Bujumbura (Burundi) where UNICEF, OHCHR, UNHCR and the Burundi Radio and Television Station (RTNB via Tera Ryarenga Broadcast) received other samples for the same purpose.
